

prof. Blanka Juhaňáková ArtD. /SK/ chairwoman of the jury

Pianist and choirmaster, Blanka Juhaňáková graduated from Bratislava Conservatory and Janáček Academy of Musical Art in Brno. She lectures conducting at the Conservatory and the Academy of Musical Art in Bratislava. Since 1989 she has been leading the mixed choir Cantus and 1991-2001 she was choirmaster of the Slovak Philharmonic Choir, with whom she prepared several notable projects.

She participated in the Boris Godunov project at the Salzburg Festival and in Japan, together with Claudio Abbado and prepared the Slovak Philharmonic Choir for the opera Rienzi by Wagner, with Zubin Mehta. In 1994 she initiated the establishment of the professional male vocal ensemble, Octet Singers, with whom she has recorded three CD's.

In 2000 she became the Chairwoman of the Commission for Choir singing in Slovakia for the National Education Centre. She is a regular member and chairman of professional juries at choir festivals and competitions both home and abroad. Since 2002 she has been a member of the Commission for Concert Artists for the Music Fund and since 2003 a member of the Artistic and Scientific Council of the Musical and Dance Faculty of Academy of Musical Art in Bratislava.

In April 2005 she made her successful debut in the Rudolfi num in Prague with the Prague Philharmonic Choir and with the Symphony Orchestra of the Czech Radio in Verdi's Requiem with the conductor Ondrej Lenárd.



Doc. Sergej Ekimov /RU/



Composer, conductor, member of the Russia Composers Union, art director of the International Choral Art Festival «The Singing World», art director and conductor of the Women's Choir at the Choir-Conducting Department of the St. Petersburg N. A. Rimsky-Korsakov Music College, professor of the

Academic Choir at the faculty of the St. Petersburg Culture and Arts University and professor of the St. Petersburg State N. A. Rimsky-Korsakov Conservatoire.

S. Ekimov is a graduate of the St. Petersburg State N. A. Rimsky-Korsakov Conservatoire, where he studied choir conducting (professor F. Kozlov) and composition (professor Yu. Falik). Post-graduate education was completed by him in 2011 at the class of professor V. Uspensky.

During the period of 1993-2009 S. Ekimov directed the St. Petersburg Youth Choir.

Among his compositions there are choral and orchestral ones, instrumental and vocal ensembles, ecclesiastic and secular music a cappella, vocal cycles, piano and choral pieces for children, music to performances, choral arrangements of Russian folk songs, popular melodies, romances.

Ekimov's opuses and transcriptions enjoyed popularity via Russia and all over the world: Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia, Ukraine, Belarus, Poland, Hungary, Austria, Germany, France, Spain, the Netherlands, Switzerland, USA and Japan.

Choir music of the 20th-21st centuries was not once the topic of his master-classes. He was also the participant and chairman of the jury at different choral festivals and contests.

Doc. Tatiana Zhdanova /RU/

Laureate of International Festivals and Competitions, children choir "Radost" Tatiana Zhdanova, the president, artistic director and chief conductor of "Radost" graduated from the Moscow State Conservatory. She has been performing and conducting for 45 years and her name is well known in Russia as well as abroad.



27 years ago she founded a musical choir school "Radost", and since then has toured with her choirs to over 30 countries of the world and 40 Russian towns, participating in choir competitions and musical choir festivals.

Tatiana Zhdanova has been awarded the President's Prize, Moscow City Administration Prize, twice has

been a Laureate of "Grant of Moscow" competition. She is an Honored Music Worker of the All-Russian Musical Society; an Outstanding Worker in People's Education; an assistant professor of Moscow State University of Education, a curator of the vocal-choir genre at The Moscow Committee of Education; the director of the Moscow International Children's Choir Festival "Moscow Sounds". This year 2006 she has been awarded the title Honored Artist. As a curator of vocal-choir genre in Moscow, Tatiana Zhdanova created a stable system of concert activities of the Moscow children choirs. She arranges vocal choir festivals, competitions, musical choir shows and parades, such as ones held during the festivals "Young Talents of Moscow", "Christmas Carol", "Easter festival".

For 20 years Tatiana Zhdanova has been an artistic director and a president of the International Children and Youth Choir Festival "Moscow Sounds", which is directed to assist the international collaboration, revelation of cultural variety, development of friendly art contacts, mutual understanding and collaboration of young people from all over the world.

prof. Benedykt Błoński /PL/



A graduate of the Fryderyk Chopin Academy of Music in Warsaw. He has worked with the Prof. W. Wawryczek Choir, currently, the choir of the University of Warmia and Mazury. With this choir, he has participated in Polish and international competitions and festivals, winning a series of the highest prizes (gold medals, as well as the Grand Prix). For his artistic and teaching activities he has been honoured with

the numerous of prestige Awards as the Gold Cross of Merit (2001), or the Honourable Golden Laurel Award of the Executive Board of the Polish Union of Choirs and Orchestras and many other. His achievements includes recordings the 13 CDs.

For years, Benedykt Błoński has been working with foreign choirs, as well as with the Warmia and Mazury Philharmonic. He has held positions in artistic councils and juries of numerous choral competitions and festivals, both domestic and international. Benedykt Błoński has been an artistic director of international choral workshops "Eurochor 2001", the artistic director of the Polish - German Choral

Academy "In terra pax", the artistic director of the F. Nowowiejski International Choir Festival. He is a member of the International Choir Olympic Council for the 2008 - 2012 term. He lectures at the Academy of Music in Bydgoszcz and the National Centre for Culture in Warsaw. Benedykt Błoński is a director and researcher in the Institute of Music in the Faculty of Arts of the Warmia and Mazury University.

In 1999 he was awarded the academic title of Professor of Musical Arts by the President of the Republic of Poland.

Doc.Mgr.Art. Štefan Sedlický /SK/

He studied piano at the Žilina Conservatory and at the University of Performing Arts in Bratislava where he also started conducting studies prof. Hradil in 1989. Since 2008 he has been the senior college lecturer at the Music Arts Faculty of the Arts Academy in Banská Bystrica where he teaches choir conducting. He also cooperates with the Pedagogical Faculty of Matej Bel University in Banská Bystrica.



He is the conductor of several choirs with whom he has achieved a lot of success both home and abroad. He directs the Žilina mixed choir (1st prize in Spittal 1992; 2nd prize in Llangollen 1997; absolute winner and conductors' prize in Prague choir days 2000; Grand Prix in Bialsko Biala etc.). He has been the conductor of the chamber choir Cantica in Martin; Academic choir of Ján Cikker in Banská Bystrica from 1998-2008 (1st prize at IFAS in Pardubice; absolute winner of Academic Banská Bystrica in 2001 and 2007). In 2002 he took the conductorship of the Slovak Teachers' Choir after prof. Hradil. With this choir he has won various international awards. Since 2009 he has been leading also the mixed choir Cansona Neosolum of the Arts Academy in Banská Bystrica. He regularly cooperates as choirmaster with the State chamber orchestra in Žilina by presenting large vocal-instrumental works.

He is active as lecturer in conductors' workshops and as juror in choir competitions in Slovakia and abroad.

Detský spevácky zbor Da Capo tvoria žiaci 3.-5. Ročníkov prevažne s rozšírenou hudobnou výchovou zo ZŠ a ZUŠ Bezdrevská v Českých Budejoviciach. Názov zboru v taliančine znamená „od začiatku“. To vystihuje každoročne sa opakujúcu systematickú prácu s malými detmi, ktoré prichádzajú z prípravného zboru Piccolo. Da Capo pravidelne vystupuje na jarných a vianočných koncertoch a na festivale Vltavské Cantare. Získal tiež množstvo ocenení na speváckych súťažach v Olomouci, v Moste, v Prahe, v Pardubiciach, v Sušici, v Lounech a v Skutči. Poslednou významnou akciou zboru bol koncert s telesom Hradišťan v Českých Budejoviciach. Repertoár tvoria prevažne ľudové piesne v rôznych úpravách a piesne pre deti od skladateľov 20. storočia.

Elementary School and Elementary Music School Bezdrevska in Ceske Budejovice. Name of the choir in Italian means „from the beginning“. It symbolizes every year's systematic work with the small children coming to the choir from the preparatory choir Piccolo. Da Capo regularly participates in spring and Christmas concerts and at Vltavské Cantare Festival. They have also won a lots of awards at the competitions in Olomouc, Most, Prague, Pardubice, Susica, Louny, Skutec. The most recent activity of the choir was a concert together with Hradistan ensemble in Ceske Budejovice. Choir's repertoire consists mostly of folksongs in different arrangements and children's songs written by 20th century composers. The choir is accompanied by the pianist Ms Lyudmyla Izugrafova. The conductor is Ms Vaclava Mikova.

65-členný dievčenský zbor **Crescent**, ktorého členkami sú dievčatá vo veku 13 - 16 rokov, si získal na singapskej zborovej scéne veľmi dobré meno. Zbor dosiahol mnohé úspechy a prešiel veľkými zmenami po tom, ako sa v roku 2012 jeho vedúcim stal oceňovaný dirigent Toh Ban Sheng spolu s tímom oddaných učiteľov Esther Lau, Zee Xinyi a Samanthou Chan. Len necelé dva roky pod taktovkou nového dirigenta stačili na to, aby zbor získal najvyššie vyznamenanie na Singapurskom mládežníckom festivale a takisto Cenu komunity na seminári šampiónov.

Dirigent Toh Ban Sheng nie je na medzinárodnej zborovej scéne žiadnym nováčikom. Písal pre Medzinárodný zborový bulletin, bol členom mnohých porôd, prednášal a často so svojimi zbormi sútážil aj v Európe. Jeho zby vyhrali okolo 60 zlatých pásem, mnoho špeciálnych cien a prvých miest, kym Toh Ban Sheng získal v Európe Cenu za dirigovanie až pätkrát. Doma dvakrát získal cenu za Zbor roka. Za jeho významný prínos v umeleckej sfére získal v roku 2006 cenu Mladý umelec. V roku 2010 vydal autobiografiu "The Accidental Conductor" (Z ničoho nič dirigentom) a v roku 2012 spustil projekt o zborovom speve s spolupráci s Earthsongs Music (USA). Počas tohto prvého európskeho turné má zbor vysoké ambície a chce sa dostať na vyššiu úroveň, aby mohol dosiahnuť vynikajúce výkony, a priniesť čarobné momenty.



The 65-strong **Crescent Girls' Choir**, aged 13 to 16, has established itself to be a respectable girls choir in Singapore. After appointing the award-winning conductor Toh Ban Sheng in 2012, with a team of dedicated teachers Esther Lau, Zee Xinyi and Samantha Chan, the choir has achieved many milestones and experienced great transformation. Barely two years under the baton of the conductor, **Crescent Girls' Choir** won the Distinction Certificate - the highest accolade - in the Singapore Youth Festival this year. 2013 also saw the choir bag the "Best CCA Award" in the Champion Seminar.

The resident conductor Toh Ban Sheng is no stranger to the international choral community, having written for International Choral Bulletin, sat on jury panel, given workshop, and competed frequently with his choirs in Europe. His choirs have won some 60 gold awards, with numerous champions and special prizes in Europe while he was awarded the Conductor's Prize five times in Europe. At home, he had twice won the Best Choir of the Year Award. For his outstanding contribution to the arts scene, he was conferred the Young Artist Award at the Istana (Palace) in 2006. His self-titled autobiography "The Accidental Conductor" was launched in 2010 and his choral series with Earthsongs Music (USA) was launched in 2012. In this inaugural European competition tour, the choir aspires to scale greater heights to embrace the spirit of excellence and magical moments.

Detský spevácky zbor Ekurhuleni založili vo februári 2005 Christine a Neels Dercksenovci. Študenti pochádzajú z rôznych etnických, sociálnych a kultúrnych podmienok vo veku 9 -17 rokov. V zbere pôsobí 35 detí z 21 škôl z Ekurhuleni Metro, Gauteng, v Južnej Afrike. Veľké percento zboristov pochádza zo znevýhodnených komunit. Zbor slúži širšej spoločnosti pi bohoslužbách, koncertoch a zborových festivaloch.

Christine Dercksen

Študovala na Katedre pedagogiky v Natal, kde sa špecializovala na hudbu. Potom pokračovala v štúdiách na Univerzite Stellenbosch. Aktívne sa objavuje na juhoafrickej zborovej scéne ako dirigentka detských zborov. Za tie roky, čo diriguje, jej zby získali mnohé národné i medzinárodné ocenenia.

The Ekurhuleni Childrens' Choir was established in February 2005 by Christine and Neels Dercksen.

Students are selected from a variety of ethnic, social, economic and cultural backgrounds with ages ranging from 9 - 17 years. The choir comprises 35 children representing 21 schools from the Ekurhuleni Metro, Gauteng, South Africa. A large percentage of the choir represents previously disadvantaged communities. The choir serves the broader community in church performances, concerts and choir festival.

Christine Dercksen

Christine Dercksen studied at the Natal Educational Department where she specialised in music. Thereafter she furthered her studies at the University of Stellenbosch. She has taken an active part in the South African Choir scene as conductor of children's choirs. Throughout the years these choirs have received various awards nationally and internationally.

Hudobné aktivity Hudobnej školy v Kaunase začali v roku 2003. Zbor založila učitelka Albina Jakubonienė. Pozostáva zo študentov školy a širšieho okruhu študentov, ktorí sa špecializujú na rôzne hudobné nástroje ako gitara, akordeón, dychové nástroje, klavír. Každý rok prichádzajú do zboru noví a noví ľudia.

Od roku 2010 vedie zbor Aisté Bagočiené. Koncertným dirigentom je Dalius Mintaučkis. Zbor sa zúčastňuje na národných študentských festivaloch, Festivale v Kaunase, v Klaipede, na detskom a mládežníckom festivale „Deti Lity“ v Klaipede. Každoročne sa zbor zúčastňuje aj na zborovom festivale „Piešen nádeje“ v Kaunase.

The activity of Kaunas 1st Music School started in 2003. The group was brought together by a teacher and supervisor Albina Jakubonienė. The choir consists of school students and extended circle of students specialized in various instruments - guitar, accordion, choral singing, brass, piano. New people join the group every year.

Since 2010, the choir is led by Aisté Bagočiené. Concertmaster Dalius Mintaučkis. Zbor Amerlingchor vznikol v roku 1991 a postupne z neho ako z malého školského zboru vyrástol nezávislý zbor s asi 50 členmi. Giuseppe Montesano

Dirigoval mnohé koncerty, operety a opery v Nemecku, Grécku, Taliansku, Rakúsku, Belgicku a Spojených štátach a často ho pozývajú ako hostujúceho dirigenta. Od júla 2013 pracuje ako asistent Neue Oper Wien vo Viedni.

Founded in Vienna in 1991, the Amerlingchor has evolved from an ambitious school ensemble into a fully independent choir with about 50 members.

Spanning 500 years of music, the choir's repertoire has focused on both sacred and secular a cappella works from the renaissance period to contemporary day. The choir has been conducted by Giuseppe Montesano since 2009.

In 2013, 24 members of the choir founded the Amerlingchor Ensemble. They traveled to Italy for the Rimini International Choral Competition, where they competed with a diverse a capella program in two categories and the Ensemble was awarded with a silver diploma in both categories.

He studied composition and piano at his hometown conservatory. He moved to Vienna where he studied orchestra conducting under Professor Georg Mark. 
Červánek pravidelne usporadúva koncerty vo svojej obci i na okolí a zúčastňuje sa na súťažiach.

Na klavíri ho doprevádzá Michaela Ondráčková, na huslách Miloslava Dočkalová a na flaute Markéta Chadimová.


