Prof. Blanka Juhaňáková, ArtD. / Slovakia - chairwoman of the jury

Pianist and choirmaster, Blanka Juhaňáková graduated from Janáček Academy of Musical Arts in Brno. In the years 1991-2001 she was the choirmaster of the Slovak Philharmonic Choir. She participated in the Boris Godunov project at the Salzburg Festival and in Japan, together with Claudio Abbado and prepared the Slovak Philharmonic Choir for the opera Rienzi by Wagner, with Zubin Mehta in Vienna State Opera House. She is a regular member and chairwoman of professional juries at choir festivals and competitions both home and abroad. In the years

2005 – 2014 she was the leading choirmaster of the Slovak Philharmonic Choir. In November 2005 she was awarded the Fric Kafenda price by the Music Fund for outstanding interpretations home and abroad. Together with the Opera Festival in St. Margarethen she prepared the Slovak Philharmonic choir to premiere the original version of Verdi's La Traviata. In 2012/2013 she and the Slovak Philharmonic choir cooperated with the Orchestre National de Lyon in staging Dvorak's Requiem with Tomas Netopil. In 2012 she got the professor's degree and was awarded a highly acclaimed 'Crystal Wing Prize' for the outstanding successes as a conductor and choirmaster on the international scene in 2011. Besides working on the Academy of Performing Arts in Bratislava, since 2014 she has been working at the Department of Composition, Conducting and Opera direction at Janáček Academy of Musical Arts in Brno.



Prof. Francesco Saverio Messina / Italy

He studied piano and composition at the «Arcangelo Corelli» State Music Conservatoire in Messina. He also graduated in Sociology from the Faculty of Sociology at the «Federico II» University in Naples. His first choral experiences were as a member of a liturgical choir, but he later went on to become both singer and conductor of several polyphonic choirs in Milazzo. He founded the Vocal Ensemble Cantica Nova in 1989 and

has been the conductor since its inception. In 2005 and 2006 he was also the conductor of the Pier Luigi da Palestrina Polyphonic choir in Messina. The concert activity carried out by the Vocal Ensemble Cantica Nova includes performances in important Italian and international locations, including Palermo, Messina, Catania, Enna, Assisi, Città di Castello, Lodi, Bucharest, Braşov. Over the years he has furthered his study of choral music, choir conducting and choral vocal technique, performance practice and interpretation, with Mino Bordignon, Franco Potenza, Pietro Righini, VoicuPopescu, Nicole Corti, Umberto Rinaldi and Maria Luisa Sánchez Carbone; also with Giovanni Acciai (study and interpretation of Renaissance music), with Gary Graden (study and interpretation of Renaissance and contemporary

music), with Werner Pfaff and with Vytautas Miskinis (study and interpretation of contemporary music), with Andrè Thomas (study and interpretation of gospel and blackspiritual) and with Alberto Turco (study and interpretation of Gregorian chant). The Vocal Ensemble Cantica Nova has participated in numerous choral competitions, including: the 28th Edition of the International choir competition Florilège Vocal de Tours (France, 1999): the 9th Edition of the National competition for young musicians in Caccamo (Palermo) where they attained First Place in the choir section (2004); the Choral Festival in Malgrat de Mar (Spain), where they attained equal Second Place (no First Place assigned, 2006); the International Choral Festival LiberCanto in Lodi attaining First Prize (2007); the Ohrid International Choir Festival (Macedonia) attaining the special prize assigned by the jury for the best performance of a Renaissance piece (2010); the 53rd Seghizzi International Choir competition in Gorizia (2014). Since 2009 he has been the Artistic Director of the International Choir Festival InCanto Mediterraneo which takes place every two years in Milazzo. Messina. In 2014-2015 he has assumed the artistic direction of a Masters course in Choir Conducting and performance practice organized under the patronage of the A.R.S. Cori (Regional Association of Sicilian Choirs).

Dr. Milan Kolena / Slovak Republic

After graduating with a degree in Choral Conducting at the University of Performing Arts (VSMU) in Bratislava under the tutelage of Prof. Peter Hradil, he also continued his studies of Gregorian Chant with Prof. J.Kohlhaufl at the University for Music and Darstellende Kunst in Vienna. He is the author of the first Slovak professional publication on Gregorian chant: "Current Directions in Interpretation of Gregorian Chant". He actively cooperates in the interpretation of Gregorian chant with Prof. Dr. F.K. Prassl from Graz and Prof. Dr. J.B. Goschl from Munich. Milan Kolena



teaches choir conducting and Gregorian chant at VŠMU. Since 1998 Milan Kolena has been the Art Director of the International festivals in Bratislava. He is active as a Jury member at national and international choral competitions all over the world. He has led many workshops and seminars about vocal polyphony, Gregorian chant and Slovak contemporary music. During 2004-2006 together with Schola Gregoriana Bratisalvensis recorded 3 CDs of Bratislava antiphons for Slovak National Library. Since 2013 he is the president of the Slovak Choral Association. In 2014 he gave lectures at three American universities: Illinois Wesleyan University School, University of Missouri School of Music, Colorado State University on the The Question of the Interpretation of Latin texts in Sacred Choral Music. He was awarded the best conductor special prize of the "Singing World" choral competition in St. Petersburg, Russia in 2015. In the same year he also did workshops in China and Hong Kong.

Jazz choir of Sverdlovsk State Children Philharmonic Society was founded under the guidance of Marina Makarova in 1988. Since that time the small group of children has turned into the creative team with about two hundred girls in it. At the present time the team consists of three age groups. The girls from eight to eleven years old study in The Junior group of Jazz choir (The conductor is Zlata Kozlovskaya). In addition to choral lessons children learn solfeggio, choreography and playing the piano. The kids get exposure to choral and theatrical culture and prepare to



work in The Senior concert team of Jazz choir. The Team perform children's songs of Russian and foreign composers, arrangements of Russian folk songs, jazz style compositions, compositions from famous groups' repertory (such as

ABBA, The Beatles, Arabesque), numbers from American musicals. The Junior group of Jazz choir is frequently competing in contests and festivals in Russia and abroad.

In the Youth Choir of the primary school OŠ. n. h. Maksa Pečarja there are 23 children aged 10 to 15 years. We regularly participate in different cultural events in our community and at school. Twice a year we join forces with the school's Children's Choir and

prepare a concert for a wider audience. In March 2017, we put on stage a very interesting and educational concert entitled Ena ptička priletela (A birdy came flying), which encompassed different folk songs from all over the world. The choir's quality was also noticed by other experts and consequently the choir held two appearances at the Slovene national conductor's seminar as a demonstrative choir. In 2017 we took part at the regional competition of children's and youth choirs of central Slovenia and won a gold award with honours as well as an award for the best choir. In the same year the choir also received an invitation to participate in the national project Potujoča muzika (Travelling music) which is held every two years and where only the chosen choirs from Slovenia can take part in. The appearance at the Bratislava international festival will be our first international competition and a great honour and challenge.



Mitja Vaupotič is a music teacher and a conductor of three choirs at the primary school OŠ n. h. Maksa Pečarja in Ljubljana, Slovenia. He has a special connection to singing and tries to fill young singers with enthusiasm

for a healthy and quality choir singing. With the choirs he participates in different events in and around the school. He is the author of the concert of folk songs entitled Ena ptička priletela (A birdy came flying), which was held in March 2017. He also appeared on several choir competitions; in 2015 he received a gold award at the regional competition of children's choirs; in 2016 he got the same award at the national competition. In 2017 he participated with the Youth Choir at the regional competition of children's and youth choirs of central Slovenia and there received a gold award with honours and an award for the best choir.

Choir Nuorisokuoro Oulun Fröökynät was founded in 1988 so this year is its 30th anniversary. It is a female choir and belongs in the Oulu YMCA organization. City of Oulu is in the northern Finland. In the main choir sings

totally 19 girls of age 13-20. There is also a junior group of 19 girls of age 7-12, in which new singers are educated for the main choir. Though choir performs mainly in the home city, it cherishes international spirit while performing / a multilingual program e.g. in English, Swedish, German, Latin, Italy, Estonian and African dialect. Every second year it travels abroad and participates in special choir festivals to gain new experiences and dimensions in singing. Thus, it has performed in several European including countries Belgium (twice), Estonia (three times), Ireland, Denmark, Czech Republic, Spain, Germany and Hungary. Choir's versatile program ranges from medieval church music to traditional women's choir repertoires, folk music from different cultures and to more experimental music types, such as pop and rock music arranged for the choir. Choir sings both



a cappella and accompanied with different instruments. It has also performed in 2016 as an opera choir in Hänsel und Gretel composed by Engelbert Humperdinc.

Since 1999's, Mr Ahti Sepp has acted as the choir conductor

for Nuorisokuoro Oulun Fröökynät. He conducts both groups of the choir - the main choir as well as the group of little girls - while groups are rehearsing and singing separately or together. Thus, he is able to prepare younger girls to change over in the main choir in the age of 13-14. During his leadership's the qualitative level of the choir as well as the variety of the program have improved remarkably. Mr Sepp urges to provide the choir versatile and international program without fearing challenges. Mr Sepp has acted as a music teacher in Estonia and Finland as well as conducted several choirs in both countries. In Finland, he has conducted not only girls' choir but as well for example a male-voice choir and chamber choir.

Primayera children's choir was founded bv PhDr. Jaroslav Dostalík (1928 - 2010) in 1992. Primavera \ choir regularly cooperates with other ensembles and institutions and performs works of Czech. Slovak as well as foreign choral composers. Recently the choir achieved some outstanding results at international festivals (2016 - Silver and Gold certificate at International Festival of Advent and Christmas music in Bratislava, 2018 – two Gold diplomas and the Grand Prix at the international festival luventus in Praga cantat).

Martina Kirová studied music education and English language at Prešov University and choral conducting at Janáček Academy of Music and Performing Arts in Brno. She works with several choirs and as a repetiteur in the National Theatre in Brno.



The Euga Male Voice Choir was founded in Finland in July 2011 by a group of young and enthusiastic musicians. The choir consists of 25 experienced choral singers, many of whom also study music. Most of the singers live in Helsinki. Turku and Tampere, hence the choir works in three cities, giving concerts several times a year. Euga performs a wide range of music, both maintaining old traditions and creating a new culture of male voice singing: the group's repertoire includes pieces from Gregorian chants and Romantic male choir classics to commissions of contemporary music, and also pieces combining classical male choir sound with electronic music. As a young male choir, Euga is a rare instrument and aims to exploit its uniqueness by fostering a bright and wellbalanced sound. The Euga Male Voice Choir was founded in Finland in July 2011 by a group of young and enthusiastic musicians. The choir consists of 25 experienced choral singers, many of whom also study music. Most of the singers live in Helsinki, Turku





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music, and also pieces combining classical male choir sound with electronic music. As a young male choir, Euga is a rare instrument and aims to exploit its uniqueness by fostering a bright and well-balanced sound.

In May 2013, the Euga Male Voice Choir attended the Sixth Cornwall International Male Voice Choral Festival and was awarded first prize in the 40 Voices and Under category in the international singing competition. A year later, Euga was honored to represent Finland in Vienna by performing in the opening concert of the Wiener Festwochen, organized by the European Broadcasting Union and the Austrian National Broadcasting Company. In April 2015, Euga won the VI International Leevi Madetoja Male Choir Competition in Tampere, Finland, and in January 2016. Euga gave a concert with the German-Nordic Youth Philharmonic at the Berliner Philharmonie. Euga's first CD, Ex Hibernis, contains Christmas music and was released in the year 2015.

The Choir of the Graduates of the Center of Creative Development of Musical and Aesthetic Education »Radost« was created out of the graduates of the Choral Department of CCD MAE »Radost«. Despite the fact that they all graduated from the Center »Radost« in different years and have long found themselves in other professions, all of them still have a love for music and choral singing. The collective successfully performed at prestigious stages in Moscow, including: the Great Hall of the Moscow Conservatory, the Svetlanovsky Hall of the International House of Music. Tchaikovsky Concert Hall, the Column Hall of the House of Unions, and others The choir is a laureate and holder of the grand prix of international competitions. The repertoire of the choir consists of the best samples of Russian





choral spiritual and classical music, Western European classics, music of contemporary composers, folk music of Russia and the world.

The artistic director and conductor of the Choir of the graduates of the Center »Radost« is Honored Artist of the Russian Federation, laureate of the Presidential Prize and the Moscow City Hall Prize Tatyana Zhdanova.

The Girls' Choir DOLCE CANTO was established in 2006 as an educational and concert ensemble and it is made of pupils and students attending Jan Cikker Art School residing in

Banska Bystrica, Slovakia. Diverse choir's repertoire contains musical compositions of wide range of styles of European classical music and covers both sacred and secular works, from Renaissance church music to music of the present day. Specific part of the repertoire belongs to ballads, spiritual and gospel songs and folk song adaptations with original instrumental accompaniment. Dolce Canto Choir choristers have been involved in various music events, benefit concerts, they regularly perform at Christmas concerts. The choir took part in live performances in Italy, Croatia and in the Czech Republic. In 2015 Jan Nosko - the Mayor of Banska Bystrica awarded The Girls' Choir Dolce Canto a special Mayor's prize for outstanding interpretative accomplishments in the realm of choral singing and presentation of the town of Banska Bystrica. In 2016 Dolce



Canto took part in an International Contest of Choral Singing 'Mundi Cantant' at the Festival of Songs 'Svatky pisni' Olomouc 2016 where the choir was awarded the Golden prize. Besides many musical activities the choir presented itself in the media by making music recordings for the

Slovak Television and the Slovak Radio.



The group "Echo" began its artistic work in 1919 and has been working under the aegis of the Community Center of Textile Workers since 1970 which is currently subordinate to the Urban Community Center in Bielsko-Biała. The group is also a member

of the Polish Association of Choirs and Orchestras. In the category of mixed choirs Echo is highly regarded on both regional and national scale gaining a lot of awards and honorable mentions during numerous festivals and competitions. The choir has been many times on tour in Belgium opening the European Flower Celebration with the concert in Waanrode. Moreover, the choir performed in Hungary, Czech Republic, Germany, Austria, Switzerland and Italy.

Teresa Adamus is both a conductor and an artistic director of the choir ECHO. Teresa Adamus is a graduate of Music Faculty of Silesian University. She has been a teacher of music for 30 years and she is the one to conduct instrumental and vocal groups of children which are highly awarded in many music competitions on regular basis.





Teresa conducted voice production and was a second conductor of the choir ECHO. In June 2011 she was assigned to conduct the choir ECHO on her own.

Fem@il Singers women's chorus was founded in 1949 as a workplace choir for the employees of the Finnish Post and

Telecommunications. Since 2001 it has been open to all female singers in the Helsinki area. The choir is a member of Sulasol (Finnish Amateur Musicians' Association) and the Association of the Finnish Women's Choirs. The singers form a registered association, which functions in co-operation with the Institute of Adult Education in Helsinki.

The choir's weekly rehearsals take place in Pakilakoti Nursing home, where the 28 singers also perform regularly, bringing joy to the residents, who often start singing along to the familiar tunes. The choir's repertoire ranges from Finnish folk songs, classical choral pieces and Christmas carols to African rhythms, schlager and pop songs. In addition to weekly rehearsals, Fem@il Singers organise two intensive voice training days each year. Two full-length concerts are produced yearly, one in the spring and one around Christmas time. The choir, and the smaller ensembles operating within the choir, also perform in choral music marathons, charity events and Christmas parties. Festivals in Finland and abroad (for example Bergen, Norway in 2010, Copenhagen, Denmark in 2012 and Verona, Italy in 2013) always belong to the most expected events.



Since 2015, Fem@il Singers have been conducted by Laura Salovaara (MMus). To celebrate the 100th anniversary of Finland's independence in 2017, the choir focused on Finnish

repertoire, which was performed in concerts, choral festivals, restaurants, nursing homes, shopping centres and even a service station. This repertoire is also the basis of what you will hear in Bratislava.

Apollo /Slovakia/

Non-competing choir

Choir Apollo was established in 1995 and in a short time the choir made considerable strides, achieving notoriety in Slovakia and receiving many awards at festivals and international competitions e.g. in Prague

(1998), Český Krumlov (2002), Olomouc (2005). The choir often gives performances at prestigious local and international events. Apollo has toured Italy and other countries performing concerts at festivals in Citta' di Nuoro, Rome, Fano, Loreto, Olbia; Poznan, Poland; Banja Luka, Bosna Hercegovina; Szeged, Miskolc, Hungary; Munich, Germany;

Prague, Olomouc, Brno and Pardubice, Czech Republic; Vienna, Austria as well as in many Slovak towns. The choir's repertoire focuses on current sacred Slovak works: the choir interprets extensive pieces by outstanding Slovak composer Pavol Krška, including Stabat Mater; Rekviem; Te Deum for solo, choir and organ; Missa Solemnis for organ, sola and mixed choir. The Apollo repertoire also includes sacred choruses from the Gregorian Chant period, as well as Renaissance and Romantic period selections; spirituals, folksongs and carols in choir arrangements. Choir Apollo has recorded a CD of Anton Bruckner works -Moteta in 2003 and made a recording of Pavol Krška's Rekviem for two choirs, sola and organ in 2012. The choir regularly sings at Holy Masses in Jesuit and other churches in Bratislava and gives charity concerts for children oncology hospital in Bratislava. It performs concerts also with University of

Performing Arts soloists or in cooperation with other Slovak or foreign choirs.

Milan Kolena is conductor, artistic director of Bratislava Music Festivals, teacher of choral conducting and Gregorian Chant at the Academy of Performing

Arts in Bratislava and the president of Slovak Choral Association. With his choir Apollo and Schola Gregoriana Bratislavensis Milan Kolena visited many prestigious choral competitions all over the Europe. During 2004-2006 together with Schola Gregoriana Bratisalvensis recorded 3 CDs of Bratislava antiphons for Slovak National Library. In 2014 he gave lectures at three American universities: Illinois Wesleyan University School, University of Missouri School of Music, Colorado State University, topic: The Question of the Interpretation of Latin texts in Sacred Choral Music. He frequently works as a member of the jury at many international choral and orchestral competitions Slovakia, Europe and Asia.




